How to get the best out of your beautiful Brackettes.

- 1. Please store your bags of Brackettes in a dry place. Once opened keep indoors.
- 2. To light the Brackettes it is essential to create a good hot bed. Use a firelighter or rolls of paper and plenty of kindling. Allow the kindling to blaze before putting on Brackettes.
- 3. Place two Brackettes on the blazing kindling making sure you have a good supply of air. Ensure the Brackettes are fully alight before restricting air vents.
- 4. When introducing more Brackettes open up vents and keep a positive air flow until the new log is flaming.
- 5. Our Brackettes produce more ash than logs, but the residue is high in potash – so it can be put straight onto the garden as a fertilizer
- 6. Empty the ash tray regularly to avoid any build-up.
